

Full Educational Opportunity Goal

The Board of Directors of Central Rivers AEA hereby reaffirms the goal of providing a full educational opportunity to all children with disabilities, ages birth through 21, within the Agency.

The Iowa Rules of Special Education require agencies to provide a full continuum of services to students requiring special education.

To facilitate implementation of the goal, the AEA assists the Iowa Department of Education in gathering information from local school districts and other agencies providing services for children with disabilities. This information includes:

- a. Number, age, disability, and location of children with disabilities receiving special education services.
- b. Number, age, disability, and location of children with disabilities not receiving special education services.
- c. Number of personnel employed by public agencies to provide special education services;
- d. Number of children with disabilities exiting the educational system.
- e. Federal, state, and local funds expended for special education and related services.
